Dear Students and Parents,

Welcome to the RCIA program for students of St. Brendan High School!

Candidates, you are preparing, in a special way, for a deeper relationship with Jesus and the Holy Spirit. Confirmation will bring you closer to God if you allow it. It will also give you the graces to go out into the world and bring God to other people. What you will learn in this short course will help you prepare for this important, life-long adventure. We, the Church, faithful on Earth and in Heaven, pray for you as you grow in your Christian witness!

Why is Confirmation a Sacrament? A person needs Baptism to be saved. A person does not need Confirmation to be saved. Why, then, does the Church offer the Sacrament of Confirmation? What does it mean to be confirmed, and why is it a sacrament?

A sacrament is a visible sign of invisible grace. Confirmation is a visible sign and a remembrance of the holy events that happened on Pentecost. After Jesus rose from the dead, He spent time with His Apostles. He opened their minds so that they could truly understand the scriptures. Before Jesus took Himself up to Heaven, He told His Apostles to stay inside and wait for the day that He would send the Holy Spirit to them. On the day we call Pentecost, the Holy Spirit came to the Apostles like a great, loud wind. The Spirit looked like fire; small flames broke off and rested on the head of every Apostle.

In Confirmation, we are, like the Apostles, given the Holy Spirit in a special way and for a special purpose. The Holy Ghost gives us the graces and strength to go out into the world and bring the Good News of Jesus to others. These graces, or Gifts of the Holy Spirit, are listed by St. Paul in the Bible in 1 Corinthians.

Together, let us pray for our candidates, parents and sponsors.

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful. Kindle the fire of your love. Send forth your spirit and they shall be created, and you will renew the face of the earth. Amen.
